### A LIGHTHOUSE FAMILY'S CHRISTMAS

“’Twas the night before Christmas and all through the house....” The Keeper’s children were nestled all snug in their beds, while visions of Flying Santa danced in their heads.

The highlight of every lighthouse family’s holiday season was a visit from Flying Santa. This legendary flight began in 1929 as a gesture of thanks to lighthouse keepers who had guided float-plane pilot Bill Wincapaw safely back to his port in Rockland.

From that year forward with the approach of December 25th, lighthouse children spent a good deal of time outside gazing across the sky and listening for the sound of an airplane’s engine. When that moment arrived, their screams of glee drew out the entire family as Santa flew over scoping out his target. They hollered and waved to Santa as he tossed out their Christmas package containing candy for the kids, a newspaper for Dad, an apron for Mama, magazines, and a Bible for the family.

The tradition continues, but today, the Friends of Flying Santa brings holiday cheer to Coast Guard families and lighthouse stewards via helicopter.
